



Royal Mail Postcode Reference 2014.08 Release Notes

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Summary

The Royal Mail Postcode Reference database contains the names of the 1.7 million unique postcodes in the United Kingdom and the grid references of all geographic postcodes.

The dataset includes centroids of postcode sectors weighted by Pitney Bowes Software according to the distribution of delivery points (addresses) within each sector.

Optimised for geocoding use, the Postcode Reference File features indexed records and a more compact file size than the original Postzon data, to allow more rapid geocoding.

Note: For a summary of the numbers of residential, non-residential, and large-user delivery points (addresses) in each postcode, and the associated ward and NHS codes, refer to the separate Royal Mail Postcode Delivery Points database.

Benefits

- The Royal Mail Postcode Reference database is ideal for geocoding records in Great Britain and Northern Ireland, for use in both Marketing and more general analyses.
- The data contains postcode sector centroids weighted by distribution of delivery points within each sector, which means that you can use the database to geocode other postcode datasets, such as customer or client records, regardless of whether they contain full postcodes or just the postcode sector centroids.
- Analysis capability is enhanced by the inclusion of Post Town and Locality fields.

GREAT BRITAIN

- There are 1,696,841 postcodes in 2014.08 versus 1,696,953 in 2014.01, an overall decrease of 112 postcodes.
- There are 6,877 new postcodes and 6,989 deleted postcodes.

NORTHERN IRELAND

- There are 48,382 postcodes in 2014.08 versus 48,332 in 2014.01, an overall increase of 50 new postcodes.
- There are 172 new postcodes and 172 deleted postcodes.
